



continued lockdown for most support.

As for what is going on with the Surgeon's duties, we are continuing to support the veterans at the hospital without one-on-one contact. We delivered 69 boxes of tea (20 per box) in May as well as pizza for the staff and patients. It has been rough not being able to support our vets at the hospital, but we have been able to assist with some presentations at various Retirement/Nursing homes. As a representative of 6785, we had the privilege of making a presentation at the Village Green Retirement Home in two locations for Memorial Day. We gave out poppies and flags with gold stands. I had the extreme honor of meeting with a 100-year-old vet (now 101) who was wearing his uniform jacket from 77 years ago.



That's about all for now. Remember our Vets, they could use some "love", recognition and acknowledgement. Cards and letters would be welcome to our VA hospital and other Veterans locations.


